This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please refer to the KJV, NIV or other versions of the Bible as an additional reference, including the version used by the student, if possible.

LESSON 1

1. because old things are passed away (gone) and all things are become new
2. reasonable, holy, acceptable to God (pleasing to God, a spiritual act of worship)
3. by the renewing of our mind
4. yield ourselves to God
5. a life of holiness and in peace
6. deny ourselves and take up our cross and follow Jesus
7. he cannot be my disciple
8. our body is the temple of the Holy Spirit and we are not our own, we are bought with a price
9. the precious blood of Christ
10. He was totally committed to the will of His Father

LESSON 2

1. the body of Jesus Christ

3. this life is no longer yours, you must separate and set yourself apart that He may dwell in you
4. cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit
5. be not conformed to the world
6. the love of the Father is not in us
7. it will corrupt the good in us
8. by doing all to the glory of God
9. his speech betrayed him (his accent gave him away)
10. out of the abundance (overflow) of the heart the mouth speaks
11. sound speech that cannot be condemned
12. fornication, uncleanness, covetousness, filthiness, foolish talking, jesting (refer to student's version)
13. good to the use of edifying that it may minister grace to the hearers (helpful to build others up for their benefit)
14. holy
15. let it be the hidden man of the heart (the inner self)
16. in our body and in our spirit which are God's
17. walk worthy of the Lord and please Him
18. in modest apparel with shamefacedness (decency) and sobriety
19. what he thinks in his heart
20. bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ
21. adulteries, fornication, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness (also refer to student's version)

23. Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you.
24. bring every work into judgment

LESSON 5

1. pray for them, love them, do good, turn the other cheek
2. go the second mile
3. the Lord's
4. with good
5. love
6. no, the Lord will judge, vengeance is His
7. shake the dust off your feet and go on in the joy of the Lord
8. a soft (gentle) answer turns away wrath
9. even Christ came not to do His own will but to do the will of His Father
10. Christian love has no limits, the love that the world has is limited by mutual respect or common interests
11. Christ died for us while we were still sinners
12. nothing
13. by their fruits (love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance)
14. by crucifying the flesh with the affections (desires) and lusts that we should not serve sin
15. none of these things move me, neither count my life dear unto myself (I consider my life worth nothing)
16. I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. (KJV) (Also refer to student's version.)

LESSON 6

1. lay aside every weight (throw off all that hinders) and the sin which easily besets us (entangles)
2. the trying (testing) of your faith works patience (perseverance)
3. come again and His reward is with Him
4. principalities, powers, rulers of the darkness of this world, spiritual wickedness in high places (heavenly realms)
5. keep ourselves under subjection, meditate upon these things, take heed (watch) to our life and doctrine, persevere in them
6. through the word of God, praying in the Holy Spirit, keeping in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life

7. I Timothy 4:7,8 exercise yourself unto godliness (train yourself to be godly) - or, previous edition:
II Timothy 4:7,8 fight a good fight, finish your course, keep the faith
8. He will teach you all things and bring all things to your remembrance, (remind you of everything I said to you)
9. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me
10. your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about (prowls) seeking whom he may devour
11. resist the devil and he will flee from you; they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony
12. take up his cross and follow Jesus
13. forget what is behind, press (strain) toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus
14. a crown of righteousness

LESSON 7

1. if we call Him Lord, we must do what He says
2. wait for it with patience
3. present our bodies a living sacrifice (total surrender), be not conformed to this world (separation), by the renewing of our mind (spiritual minded)
4. yes
5. Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.
6. All scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness. (The infallible word of God is the final authority in such matters.)
7. by the examples in scripture, written for our admonition (to keep us from evil in our hearts)
8. the Spirit of truth (Holy Spirit)
9. the peace of God
10. God turns evil things (or a bad situation) into good; God will turn a curse into a blessing
11. they were forbidden (prohibited, not allowed) by the Holy Spirit

LESSON 8

1. lay it aside (throw it off) and run the race with patience
2. it is sin (whatever is not of faith is sin)
3. sin
4. put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh to fulfill its lusts
5. no
6. not distressed (not crushed), not in despair, not forsaken (not abandoned), not destroyed
7. the inward man is renewed day by day
8. encouraged himself in the Lord (found strength in the Lord)
9. Satan will take advantage of us
10. faith
11. wait on the Lord, be of good courage and He shall strengthen your heart
12. submit to God, resist the devil, draw nigh to God, be cleansed from sin, purify our hearts, not be double minded, repent for wrong attitudes, humble ourselves
13. the prosperity of the wicked (jealousy, for the riches of this world)
14. he went into the sanctuary of God and understood their end (final destiny) - or - his eyes were lifted from the circumstances to God
