CHAPTER 13

1. repent
2. cut it down - leave it alone and dig around it and fertilize it and wait to see if it bears fruit
3. 18 years - a spirit of infirmity (Satan or an evil spirit bound her)
4. he was angry, indignant because Jesus healed on the sabbath
5. each one releases his ox or donkey and leads it to water on the sabbath day
