TOTAL POINTS POSSIBLE: 173 (1 point for each blank)

This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please refer to the KJV, NIV or other versions of the Bible as an additional reference.

4. answers may vary in wording: he tempted Adam and Eve to sin
5. a. good for food, b. pleasing to the eyes, c. desirable to make one wise
6. a. lust of the flesh (cravings of sinful man), b. lust of the eyes, c. the pride of life (the boasting of what he has and does)
7. answers may vary: three - v. 2 natural desires of the body (to turn stones into bread), v. 5 the pride of life (to jump off the temple), v. 8 things pleasant to the eyes (to worship Satan)

10. they would die
11. with Eve
12. man (husband)
13. the woman is the glory of man, the first woman came from man, the woman was created for man

30. they were punished by God and vomited (cast) out of the land

31. a near relative
32. clans and families
33. do not yield or listen to him, show him no pity
34. the Lord
35. answers will vary, accept any answer from the scriptures listed
36. each family member who sins
37. things they had experienced and things that their fathers had told them
38. parents were to explain it to their own children
39. the greatness of His works and His almighty power
40. the descendants (children and grandchildren) would know God and His mighty works and they would trust the Lord and obey His commandments
41. they did not trust (believe) in the Lord who had redeemed them, they continued to sin by rebelling against God
42. sons would be like well nurtured plants and daughters like beautiful pillars that adorn a palace

 45. accept any answer based on Ezekiel 18:19-24
 46. they were to receive a portion of land as their inheritance
 47. an adulterous woman, a harlot, because Israel was guilty of spiritual adultery
 48. answers may vary somewhat: v. 1 - fear not for I have redeemed you, I have called you by name, you are mine
 v. 2 - when you pass through waters, I will be with you; when you pass through rivers they will not overflow (sweep over) you, when you pass through fire you won't be burned
 v. 3 - I give Egypt for your ransom, Cus and Sheba in your place
 v. 4 - I will give men and peoples in exchange for your life
 vv. 5,6 - I am with you, I will bring your children from the east and west, north and south, sons and daughters from the ends of the earth will return to Israel
 49. I have loved you with an everlasting love, I have drawn you with lovingkindness
 50. she is not my wife, I am not her husband
51. because they are the children of adultery (whoredoms)
 52. Ishi, or husband
 53. I will betroth you to me forever, in righteousness and justice (judgment), in love and compassion (lovingkindness and in mercies), in faithfulness

89. their king, the Lord
90. every man will sit under his own vine and fig tree and no one will make them afraid
91. Prince of Peace
92. the Lord will bless his people with peace
93. depart from evil, seek peace and pursue it
94. accept any answer based on verses 2-4
95. wording of the answer may vary: there will be mistrust between husband and wife, a son dishonors his father, a daughter rises up against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law, a man's enemies are those of his own household
96. God of his salvation (Savior)
97. He pardons sins and transgressions, he will not stay angry forever but delights in mercy
98. the kingdom of God and his righteousness
99. he is not worthy of Jesus
100. Is it time for you to live in furnished (ceiled) houses while the Lord's house lies in ruins (waste)?
101. wording may vary: (vv. 5,6) you plant much but reap little, you eat but never have enough, you drink but are not filled, you put on clothes but are not warm, he that earns wages puts them into a bag with holes in it (vv. 9,10) you expected much but received little, what you brought home the Lord blew away, the heavens have withheld their dew and the earth its crops
102. answers may vary: because the Lord's house remains in ruins while each of you was busy with your own house
103. the glory of the latter house will be greater than the former and I will grant peace
104. the Spirit of the Lord
105. old people will sit in the streets and the streets will be filled with boys and girls playing
106. honor that is due to the father by the son
107. blind, crippled (lame), sick and diseased animals
108. to God
109. create in me a clean (pure) heart and renew a right (steadfast) spirit within me
110. Judah married the daughter of a foreign (strange) god
111. because of the hardness of their hearts

135. wording may vary: it was against Jewish law for a Jew to associate with a Gentile
136. because God told him not to call anything impure that God had made clean
137. Cornelius, his relatives and friends
138. God is no respecter of persons (does not show favoritism)
139. the Holy Spirit came on all those who heard the word of God
140. to be baptized in water because they had received the Holy Spirit in the same way the apostles had

141. a great multitude that no one could number from every nation, tribe, people and language
142. salvation
143. wording may vary: v. 24 - to the sinful desires or lusts of their own hearts, to sexual impurity (to dishonor their bodies between themselves), v. 26 - to shameful lusts (vile affections)
144. 23,000 of them died in one day
145. our body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, we are not our own, we are bought with a price
146. the precious blood of Christ
147. flee (run away from) the temptations
148. many troubles
149. God will judge them
150. accept any answer based on I Cor. 7:32-35

151. the husband should love his wife as he loves himself, the wife should respect (reverence) her husband
152. Wives: submit to your husband as is fitting in the Lord

Fathers: do not embitter (provoke to anger) your children or they will become discouraged
