This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please refer to the KJV, NIV or other versions of the Bible as an additional reference.

CHAPTER 1

1. eyewitnesses and ministers of the word
2. it is God inspired (God breathed)
3. they had no child and they were both old (advanced/stricken in years)
4. answers will vary
5. doubt and wanting a sign
6. she found favor, grace from God
7. nothing is ever impossible with God
8. answers may vary: Mary did not doubt; she said let it be done according to thy word, but Zachariah doubted and asked for a sign
9. my soul magnifies the Lord, my spirit rejoices in God my savior
10. John the Baptist, he baptized in water, he prepared the way of the Lord, and made ready a people

6. they were filled with madness and rage and discussed what they might do with Jesus
7. He went into a mountain, He prayed all night

9. answers will vary: the people were delivered from unclean spirits, healed of diseases - all were healed

9. answers will vary: build ourselves up, study the Bible, encourage ourselves in the Lord
10. answers will vary: cut off deeds of the flesh, lay aside sins, guard our hearts
11. answers will vary: listen and apply the word of God to our lives, seek God with all of our hearts
12. my mother and brethren are those who listen to the word of God and do it
13. a. Jesus calmed the wind and waves, b. Jesus delivered a demon possessed man and allowed the demons to enter a herd of swine, c. Jesus healed the woman with an issue of blood, d. Jesus raised Jairus' daughter from the dead
