This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please refer to the KJV, NIV or other versions of the Bible as additional references, including the version used by the student if possible.

JEHOSHAPHAT'S PRAYER

1. X
2. feared/was afraid/alarmed
3. he sought the Lord (resolved to inquire of the Lord), he proclaimed a fast
4. Judah, out of all the cities with their wives and little ones (children)
5. King Jehoshaphat, in the house of the Lord (the temple)
6. truth in the inward parts, a clean heart, a broken spirit and a contrite heart
7. a house of prayer for all peoples (nations)

32. witchcraft (divination NIV)
33. they did not listen/we will not walk in God's ways
34. confusion of faces (covered with shame)
35. curses and oaths (sworn judgments) written in the law of Moses
36. answers may vary depending on the translation used - they did not pray/seek the Lord's favor, nor turn from their iniquities, sins, and understand the truth
37. a reproach (object of scorn) to those round about them

42. a. hear (listen), b. forgive, c. hearken (hear), d. do (act), e. defer not (do not delay)
