This answer key is provided as a guide for the corrector. Answers should be graded on basic content rather than specific wording in most cases. Please use the KJV, NIV, NLT or other versions of the Bible as additional references, including the version used by the student if possible.

THE CONCEPTS OF THE KINGDOM

1. head of fine gold, b. chest (breast) and arms of silver, c. belly and thighs of brass (bronze), d. legs of iron, e. feet were part (a combination) of iron and (baked) clay
2. a great stone (rock) cut out without hands (by supernatural means)

67. we will reap (a harvest of blessing)
