6. His heart fainted for he didn't believe them

1. To make of him a great nation
2. 130
3. Ephraim

CHAPTERS 49 & 50

1. The same cave Abraham bought (Ephron or Machphelah)
2. A very great company
3. Verses 16-21
4. God will surely visit you and bring you out of this land into the land he promised – be sure to take my bones and bury them there
